- Prepare **comforting miso soup** from scratch, using umami-packed *dashi* made the traditional way

Everything is taught step by step, with the support of a **local English-speaking guide**—so you'll feel confident recreating the experience at home!

After cooking, we'll **sit down together to enjoy the meal**. Then, we'll clean up together—the Japanese way! **The workshop ends around 1:00 PM.**
